

Statute of the Allocation Committee

1. Allocations to Akademikerhilfe student residences are decided in meetings of a committee consisting of the following members appointed by the Akademikerhilfe honorary board:
 - a) the Chairperson of the Committee and
 - b) a second member of the honorary board

If no second member of the board is appointed his/her function will be taken on by the Secretary General. The latter is to be co-opted to the meetings in an advisory function in any case.

2. Allocations may also be decided by sending the lists of applications and the allocation suggestions to the members of the Allocation Committee and to the Akademikerhilfe Chairman by e-mail or by mail. The Chairperson of the Committee acknowledges or amends the suggestions. These decisions will be passed on to the second member of the honorary board, to the Chairman and to the Secretary General. If they do not demand any amendments, the decisions are to be carried out by the Chairperson.
3. Allocations are made with regard to the purpose and dedication of Akademikerhilfe residences in compliance with the principles laid down in section B of the Residence Statute. The interests of the sponsors of Akademikerhilfe will be considered as well.
4. For certain periods of time the Allocation Committee may delegate their responsibility to the Secretary General in order to accelerate the allocation of vacancies.
